



Alumni Legacy Tuition Reduction Scholarship Application

The Alumni Legacy Scholarship Program has been developed to encourage children and grandchildren who are away from the state and region to consider attending Marshall University by providing a scholarship that would help offset the difference between in-state and non-resident tuition costs. To qualify for the award amounts below, the student must be entering as a first-time full-time freshman and be charged non-resident tuition rates. The parent or grandparent must be an active (dues paying) member of the Marshall University Alumni Association.

Tier I: Award amount is up to \$7,500. Requirements: A minimum of 25 ACT composite score (or SAT equivalent) and a 3.5 high school grade-point average.

Tier 2: Award amount is up to \$6,000. Requirements: A minimum of 23 ACT composite score (or SAT equivalent) and a 3.0 high school grade-point average. Or, a student who has a composite ACT score of 21 or 22 and a minimum high school grade-point average, who has demonstrated leadership through high school activities or community service may also be considered.

The Alumni Legacy Scholarship is a 4-year annual award, which is renewable if the student is enrolled full-time and maintains a minimum GPA of 2.0. The Alumni Legacy Scholarship award amount may not exceed the maximums stated above. The Alumni Legacy Scholarship is reduced when a student also qualifies for other Marshall University scholarships such as Border State, Appalachian and John Laidley. For example, if a student qualifies for both Alumni Legacy-Tier I and Border State, the student would be awarded Border State in the amount of \$3,500 and Alumni Legacy Scholarship in the amount of \$4,000.
